The reaction of Churches in Europe to the economic crises

Since the year 2008 Europe has been facing ongoing economic crises, starting with a crisis in financial markets, followed by a fiscal and political crisis in the European Union. The CALL network would like to produce an overview of the reaction of the churches in Europe to that. What is their analysis of the crises? How do they perceive the social and economic impact of the crises? What is their theological perception of the current situation in Europe? What solutions do they offer?

We therefore send you this questionnaire with the intention of acquiring an overview of the church positions with regard to the social and economic challenges in Europe. The results are intended to support church leaders in finding common responses to the crisis and strengthening their national position. The group will discuss the results and make them available to you and to our member churches.

We adopt this procedure as a first step towards a more united position of the European churches on the way to an economically sustainable Europe. The purpose of the survey is to enable the churches to recognize common ground in spite of the different situations facing each country. They may then want to join forces in order to strengthen their impact.

If you could return the questionnaire by the end of July the working group will come up with the results by Autumn 2013.
