An assembly of the World Council of Churches

- Expression of the living fellowship of 349 WCC member churches in prayer, celebration and decision making
- Highest governing body of the WCC
- Largest most diverse gathering of Christians in the world – 825 member church delegates – ecumenical partners and other churches
- Offers the potential to affirm common direction for the one ecumenical movement



A new style of WCC assembly

- Space for member churches and ecumenical partners to move towards a shared vision
- Rooted in common prayer, Bible study, celebration and reflection
- Prepared in the spirit of "togetherness" based on the ethos of fellowship and consensus
- Coherent programme where all elements build upon each other – clear flows and linkages
- Separation between business and celebration




