Ulrich H. J. Körtner is since 1992 Professor of Systematic Theology (Reformed Theology) at the Faculty of Protestant Theology of the University of Vienna; Head of the Institute; born 1957. After studying Protestant Theology in Bethel, Münster and Göttingen, assistant and vicariate at the Kirchliche Hochschule Bethel and in Bielefeld. 1982 doctorate. 1987 Habilitation at the Bethel Church College. 1986-1990 parish priest in Bielefeld, 1990-1992 director of studies at the Protestant Academy in Iserlohn. Scientist of the Year 2001. In 2010 he was awarded an honorary doctorate by the Institut Protestant de Théologie/Faculté libre de Théologie Protestante de Paris, in 2013 an honorary doctorate by the Reformed Theological University of Debrecen. 2015 Vienna Prize for Humanistic Research on Ageing. 2016 Decoration of Honour for Science and Art I. Class of the Republic of Austria and Wilhelm Hartel Prize of the Austrian Academy of Sciences (OeAW).
